

Frequently Asked Questions about Northland Christian School

- 1. How long has the school been in existence?** Northland Christian was founded in 2007 with the integration of Northland Christian High School and Life Christian Academy, which has a 30-year history of Christian education in Kansas City's Northland. Northland Christian is an independent, non denominational Christian school.
- 2. What textbooks do you use?** Bob Jones and ABeka primarily. We have written our own curriculum and textbooks provide the support.
- 3. Do you have a hot lunch program? How long is lunch?** We do offer a hot lunch program. Elementary and secondary lunches are 30 minutes. Parents are always welcomed to eat lunch with their children.
- 4. What extracurricular activities do you offer?** NC offers the following opportunities for athletics beginning in fifth grade: volleyball, basketball, soccer and track. NC also offers: praise and worship, student council, ministry team, and ACSI competitions. (Competitions include: art, speech, spelling bee, science, creative writing, and math olympics)
- 5. What electives do you offer?** Music, Physical Education, Art, Computer and Library
- 6. Do students have a lot of homework?** We believe homework is important to the academic development of our students. We are constantly monitoring with staff about how much is too much in homework for students. From past alumni, their comments have been that the amount of homework prepared them for college.
- 7. What are the school hours?** 8 am to 3 pm
- 8. What is the dress code?** Kindergarten – 6th Grade wear uniforms. They may wear any solid color, long or short sleeve polo shirt and black khaki or navy pants. Grades 7-12th are not required to wear uniforms. Please review the handbook for a complete description of the dress code and secondary dress expectations.
- 9. Do you have chapel? How often?** Yes. Secondary students (7-12) have chapel on Tuesday mornings and elementary students (K-6) have chapel on Thursday mornings. Parents are always welcomed and encouraged to attend chapel.
