

# Prayer Guide

- **Praise** – “Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise: His greatness no one can fathom.” Psalms 145:3

Praise God for whom He is, what He has done for us, and the blessings we have today, some of which include: students, staff, facilities, unity of believers from many backgrounds, freedom to worship and learn about Christ, principals, spiritual growth, salvation.

- **Desire for God’s will to be done** – “Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. *Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.*”

We desire for God’s will and purpose to be accomplished in Northland Christian School --in the lives of our students, our staff, our families and our church and community partners.

- **Provision** – “Until now, you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.” (John 16:24)

**Finances** – That God would provide funds for the current budget deficit in his perfect timing. That He might guide us to businesses, churches and individuals who have a heart for Christian Education and would be willing to partner with us financially. Pray for showers of financial blessing for those who help meet our needs.

**Facility** – That God would meet our facility needs – giving us the buildings and grounds needed to effectively educate children with a biblical worldview. We ask His guidance for short-term and long-term planning and the capital provision to accomplish His goals and plans.

**Wisdom** – That God would provide wisdom to all the individuals involved in evaluating and making decisions regarding the operation of our school. This would include our administrators, board members, facility team, and staff. (If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. James 1:5)

**Faith** – That our faith would be sure and our confidence in God’s plan for this school – the students, families and staff – will come to pass according to His will. May we be known as a school of faith – faith in God and in a plan that exceeds the dreams and desires of man. (Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.)

**Families** – That parents who sacrifice to send children to our school would see God’s provision. For families currently experiencing financial stress that they would seek God’s peace and guidance.

**Students** – That they would have a heart to know and serve the Lord. For those who don’t know Christ as their savior to desire a personal relationship with him. That God would guide our students, especially seniors, as they make important decisions about the future. For behavior and attitudes that are always Christ honoring.

**Staff** – For God’s provision for their families as they serve a mission field at NCE. That God would give them insight into teaching and opportunities to share Christ’s love with students. Pray that God will help their relationship with the Lord to grow as they pour into the lives of others.

**Perspective** – That God would help us focus not on what is temporary but on what is eternal. Give us the compassion of Christ to see and meet needs.

- **Praise Him** – “Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise – the fruit of lips that confess His name” Hebrew 13:15. Join others in praising God.
