

A+ Recognition Scholarships

Missouri Four-Year Colleges and Universities

Updated October 2018

The A+ Schools Program is funded through the State of Missouri for Missouri public community colleges and vocational/technical schools. However, some 4-year colleges in Missouri offer their own A+ recognition scholarships. These scholarships are determined by the colleges themselves and may or may not be offered at any time. CHECK WITH THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE AT 4-YEAR COLLEGES AND ASK IF THEY OFFER ANY INCENTIVES FOR A+ STUDENTS.

| Missouri State University | \$500 per year | Freshman/Renewable | 100 scholarships available statewide. Must apply for admission and submit the A+ Recognition Scholarship Application by January 15. Renewable with completion of 30 hours and 3.0 cum GPA. Not stackable with other MO State academic scholarships. | 800-283-4243 |
| Missouri Valley College | ½ Tuition | Freshman, renewable up to 5 yrs Not stackable | Awarded to any student who completes the A+ requirements. Must live on campus. | 660-831-4000 |
