I wish to participate in Northland Christian's A+ Schools Program. **If state funds are available**, I will receive reimbursement for the college expenses determined by legislative approval and appropriation of funds each year. This is on the condition that I meet the following requirements:

- Attend an A+ high school for three years immediately prior to graduation (10th-12th grade).
- Earn a cumulative high school grade point average of a 2.5 grade point or higher on a 4.0 scale (non-weighted).
- Maintain a 95% high school attendance record for the 4-year period (attendance is not rounded up).
- Perform 50 documented hours of approved and unpaid tutoring and/or mentoring. 25% of hours can be obtained through job shadowing or internship.
- Establish a record of good citizenship with no drug or alcohol offenses.
- Make a documented good faith effort to secure federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds during the last semester of the senior year so as to obtain the A+ financial incentive (FAFSA).
- Register for Selective Service, if applicable (as required by law).

To retain this eligibility after high school graduation, I understand that I must enroll and attend on a full-time basis a Missouri public community college or public career/technical school, AND maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

\*This agreement signifies a student's intention to meet or exceed the A+ criteria. A+ tuition reimbursement is contingent upon the availability of state funds. The financial incentives of the A+ Schools Program are dependent upon state appropriations from the Missouri General Assembly. The incentives are not the funding responsibility of Northland Christian School. Student financial incentives may be accessed over a four-year period after graduation and contingent upon legislative approval. All individuals required to register with the Selective Service must do so to be eligible for state-supported scholarships and programs for financial assistance for post-secondary education. Students must fill out the FAFSA no earlier than October of their senior year in order to be eligible for A+ funding at the post-secondary institution.
